
VISIT RWANDA

3 DAYS AND 2 NIGHTS BEAUTIFUL RWANDA EXPERIENCES KIGALI AND KIBUYE



DAY1: ARRIVAL IN KIGALI & KIGALI CITY TOUR, RWANDA ART MUSEUM AND CHOOSE KIGALI ART GALLERY

Arrival at the Airport later start the Kigali city exploration, get to learn more about Rwanda from the pre-colonial, colonial and post-colonial era as well as Genocide times. Start with Belgian camp which is near the hotel, where 10 UN peace keepers were killed before Genocide trying to protect the moderate Prime minister, later Visit the Kigali Genocide

Memorial where over 250,000 Genocide victims were put to rest in mass graves.



After lunch you will proceed visiting Rwanda Art Museum formerly the Presidential Palace Museum, this new museum displays contemporary artworks from Rwanda as well as abroad. The museum seeks to provide an insight into the originality of Rwandan creativity. Exploring the development of art from olden times to the modern day, it considers how traditional and modern imaginations can blend and fuse.

The flight debris from the presidential jet that went down on 6th April 1994 remain in situ in the garden and this will remain a heritage site.



After you will transfer to visit Choose Kigali art gallery allows for a wider range of artists to show their work, in a greater range of formats. The gallery and tiered gardens are built for an ideal event space. With few bespoke events spaces in the city.



After you will transfer to hotel. **Overnight at Mille Colline Hotel / MA Boutique Hotel**

DAY2: TRANSFER TO KIBUYE BOAT CRUISE AND VISITING NAPOLEON ISLAND AND OTHER ISLANDS

Breakfast then drives to Lake Kivu, the Rwanda's most attractive of lake ports, nestled in a series of interwoven and undulating hills and offering visitors spectacular views of the lake, its islands and the stunning surrounding countryside. It is considered as one of Rwanda's hidden treasures, with its lush green hills and peaceful breeze. Paddling across the coastline of Lake Kivu by boat ride is a wonderful way to immerse yourself in the scenic, mountainous backdrop and tranquility of the water.

The clear, pristine lake has an ire-regular shoreline, dotted with islands. There are no hippos or crocodiles, making it a safe and seamless experience.

Boat excursion in Lake Kivu to Napoleon Island famous for its fruit bats and proceed visting other islands like amahoro, peace and monkey islands. Dinner and overnight at cormorant lodge/ Moriah hill Hotel.
