DAY1: KIGALI CITY EXPLORATION (PRE-COLONIAL, COLONIAL AND POST-COLONIAL ERA AS WELL AS GENOCIDE TIMES AND VISIT FAZENDA RECREATION CENTER

After breakfast you will start Kigali city exploration, get to learn more about Rwanda from the pre-colonial, colonial and post-colonial era as well as Genocide times. Start with Visit the Kigali Genocide Memorial where over 250,000 Genocide victims were put to rest in mass graves.



After lunch you will transfer to Fazenda Sengha located on Mt. Kigali, Fazenda is an outdoor recreational center that offers horseback riding experiences, zip-lining and quad bikes experience. **Overnight at Marriot Hotel**



DAY2: TRANSFER TO AKAGERA GAME DRIVE AND BOAT CRUISE

Transfer to Akagera National Park 2hours and a half from Kigali, this park is Rwanda's largest national park and covers an area of approximately 1,122 square kilometers (433 square miles). The park is known for its diverse wildlife, including elephants, hippos, crocodiles, and a variety of bird species. It's also home to predators like lions, leopards, and hyenas. Akagera National Park offers opportunities for safaris, game drives, and boat trips along the Akagera River. It's a beautiful Place, on arrival at the reception later start game drive in the

park in search of animals, get the opportunity to see over 11 species of antelopes, and over 480 species of birds including the rare ones such as the shoe bill stock, papyrus gonolek, and the big 5 i.e. Lion, Leopard, Rhino, Buffalo and Elephant, your favorite ungulate, the topi, some of the 480-bird species including 4 Albertine rift endemics, reptiles, amphibians, plants, magnificent landscapes, historical sites; a place with the highest concentration of birds per square kilometer than any national park of Africa.



In the afternoon, you will drive to Lake Ihema for the thrilling boat ride to see schools of hippos, giant Nile crocodiles, different water birds, etc.

Overnight at Ruzizi Tented Lodge

DAY3: FULL DAY GAME DRIVE AND TRANSFER BACK TO

Today starts with an exciting Game Drive in destination for wildlife enthusiasts and those looking to experience the natural beauty of Rwanda. You will start with game drive where you will get the opportunity to see over 11 species of antelopes, over 525 species of birds including the rare ones such as the shoe bill stock, papyrus gonolek and the big 5 i.e. Lion, Leopard, Rhino, Buffalo and Elephant) to mention but a few. The park has the highest concentration of birds per square kilometer, very beautiful undulating landscapes, high species numbers and endemic species plus historical and cultural sites inside the park.



After you will exit to the park and transfer back Kigali.

DAY4: TRANSFER TO KIBUYE BOAT CRUISE AND VISITING NAPOLEON ISLAND AND OTHER ISLAND

Breakfast then drives to Lake Kivu, the Rwanda's most attractive of lake ports, nestled in a series of interwoven and undulating hills and offering visitors spectacular views of the lake, its islands and the stunning surrounding countryside. It is considered as one of Rwanda's hidden

treasures, with its lush green hills and peaceful breeze. Paddling across the coastline of Lake Kivu by boat ride is a wonderful way to immerse yourself in the scenic, mountainous backdrop and tranquility of the water. The clear, pristine lake has an irregular shoreline, dotted with islands. There are no hippos or crocodiles, making it a safe and seamless experience. Boat excursion in Lake Kivu to Napoleon Island famous for its fruit bats and proceed visiting other islands like Amahoro, Peace and Monkey Islands. **Dinner and overnight at Cleo Lake Kivu.**



DAY5: TRANSFER TO GISENYI BOAT EXCURSION AND HOTSPRING AND TRANSFER BACK KIGALI

Breakfast then transfers to Rubavu formerly Gisenyi a waterfront town on the shores of Lake Kivu, Rubavu is an hour away from the Volcanoes National Park, and makes a good stopover on the way to or from Nyungwe, or somewhere to relax after gorilla tracking Rubavu, as well as other spots along Lake Kivu, has sandy beaches, warm, clean water

and an easygoing tropical character. It is a great place to unwind, soak up the tranquil vibe, watch the birds and enjoy various watersports.

Boat tour at Lake Kivu, these rides allow you to enjoy the beautiful scenery, visit nearby islands, and get a different perspective of the lake and its surroundings. It's a great way to appreciate the natural beauty of the area and unwind while taking in the views.

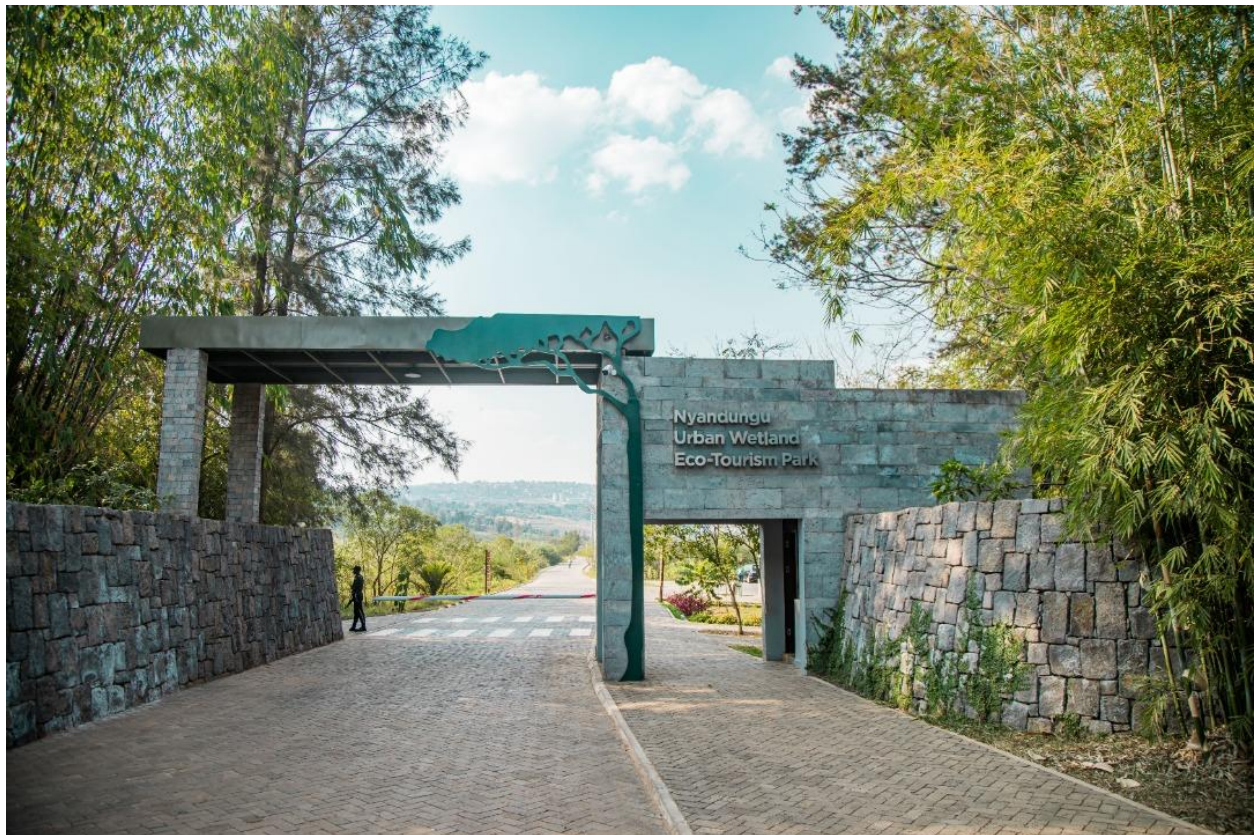
